The primary responsibility of the “Rock and Read” Assistant is to do community service within the guidelines for the government’s literacy programs for infants and preschoolers.

- Provide reading to children ages 0-5 in a local day care or classroom, both one-on one and within a group setting.
- Participate in an orientation that includes the specific policies of the day care or classroom setting.
