

Five-year Average Credentialing Examination Pass Rate

Five-year average credentialing examination, American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) Radiography exam, pass rate of not less than 75 percent at first attempt within six months of graduation.

Five-year Average Job Placement Rate (JPR)

JPR is defined as the number of graduates employed in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, or medical dosimetry compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the specific field. For this purpose “specific field” will refer to radiography, radiation therapy, medical dosimetry, and magnetic resonance.

[^] Due to the most recent JRCERT JPR definition, numbers and percentages have been adjusted accordingly.

^{*}The JRCERT has defined “not actively seeking employment” as:

1. Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status **after multiple attempts OR**
2. Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation **OR**
3. Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours **OR**
4. Graduate is on active military duty **AND/OR**
5. Graduate is continuing education.

^{**}Graduates that continued their education and found “specific field” employment within 12 months were included in employment numbers; graduates that continued their education and did not work in the “specific field” were included in the continued education column.

Five-year Annual Program Completion Rate

Program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length.

| 2016 | 100% | 20 of 20 graduated |

| 5 year average | 96% | 103 of 107 students graduated |
