Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) III
30-day Report
June 30, 2021

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) is authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP), Public Law 117-2, signed into law on March 11, 2021, providing \$39.6 billion in support to institutions of higher education to serve students and ensure learning continues during the COVID-19 pandemic.

ARP funds are in addition to funds authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Public Law 116-260 and the Coronavirus Aid, Recovery, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Public Law 116-136. Emergency funds available to institutions and their students under all emergency funds total \$76.2 billion.

HEERF III

Cox College has received authorization from the US Department of Education in the amount of \$1,762,128.00. Amounts are designated as follows, for students, \$898,008.00 for the institution: \$864,120.00. Funds will be disbursed during the Summer 2021 semester and the 2021-2022 academic year.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS PRIORITY GROUP ONE

According to HEERF III funding eligibility requirements, and other stipulations, recipients will be prioritized by exceptional need. (Summer 2021 enrolled students receiving a Pell Grant will be automatically funded)

Priority Group One - Pell eligible students that meet the criteria below.

- Student must have a 2020-21 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) received and on file at Cox College.
- Student must be enrolled in at least 1 Credit hour in the Summer 2021 semester.
- Demonstrate exceptional need based upon an official Expected Family Contribution (EFC) from the FAFSA
