

Cox College VA COLLEGE FINANCING PLAN- SHOPPING SHEET FAQ

What is the VA College Financing Plan?

The College Financing Plan is a consumer tool Cox College is using to notify students who file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and are using Veterans Affairs Educational Benefits. It is a standardized form that is designed to simplify the information that prospective students receive about costs and financial aid so that they can make informed decisions.

Will all veteran students have access to the College Financing Plan?

Only students who file a FAFSA and indicate that they are using VA Education Benefits will have access to the Financing Aid Plan - Shopping Sheet.

Where will I find my Financing Aid Plan?

A Financing Aid Plan will be emailed to your Cox College student email account. One may be printed for you if requested.

What is the Estimated Cost of Attendance?

The estimated cost of attendance (COA) is intended to provide you with an idea of what it will cost you to attend Cox College as a student, enrolling for the Fall and/or the Spring semester. The Cost of Attendance includes **an estimated budget amount** for tuition and fees, room and board, books, transportation and miscellaneous personal expenses. Your own expenses will vary depending on a variety of factors, including enrollment, housing and lifestyle choices.
